NORTH SQUAD

The North squad will be coached by Jeff Stein from Mount Abraham Union H.S. Report to the Norwich University football field no later than 11:00am, Sunday, November 13th.

SOUTH SQUAD

The South squad will be coached by Chad Gordon from Mount Anthony Union H.S. Report to the Rutland H.S. locker room no later than 11:00am, Sunday, November 13th.

PRACTICE DETAILS:

1. Sunday's practice will be held from 11 am - 3 pm. **Players who have just participated in the championship games on Saturday will be expected to be at this practice.** (Don't worry, it is an organizational practice with little physical demands). You must provide all of your own football equipment, including helmet, mouth-guard, shoulder pads, hip & tail pads, thigh pads, knee pads, and cleats. You must also provide your own practice jersey and white practice pants. Pants without any leg stripe or other adornment are requested.
2. A GAME JERSEY WILL BE PROVIDED FOR YOU. The game jersey must be returned immediately after the game's conclusion. **It will be available for purchase for \$35. Payment will be made during the week to your coaching staff or site coordinator.**
3. A team and individual photographs for the program will be taken Sunday, November 13th. This is the ONLY day pictures for the program will be taken. Game jerseys will be issued for the team photograph, then immediately collected.
4. Your coach will inform you on Sunday of any practice time changes. If a team can not practice due to inclement weather, a make-up date will be decided by the coaching staff.
5. **If, due to inclement weather, you are unsure if practice will be held on a specific day, please call your head coach at the contact number he will provide to you.** If he is NOT available, he will leave a message at that number by 12 Noon on the day in question.
6. Barring emergencies, you will be expected to attend and participate in each practice leading up to game day. Punctuality is essential! If you experience transportation difficulties, contact your own HS head coach for assistance. It may be wise for you to arrange car-pooling with other players from your high school and/or general area.
